



Online/Onsite Program for Teachers: **Portraits Then and Now** Spring 2010

The Milwaukee Art Museum and the Metropolitan Museum of Art present a series of online/onsite seminars for teachers in Spring 2010. Two 75-minute webinars utilize the extensive collections of both museums, and culminate in an onsite workshop, during which participants at each museum will engage with artwork in the galleries and interact with each other via the Internet. At all sessions, participants take part in a wide range of activities that can be adapted for students in the classroom. The theme of the series is portraiture, with a special focus on the exhibition of Raphael's Renaissance masterpiece, *Woman with the Veil*, on view March 26, 2010–June 6, 2010 at the Milwaukee Art Museum, and *The Drawings of Bronzino*, on view January 20, 2010–April 18, 2010 at the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
